The student portal will be activated at 7 am on March 16. Students who have an active lionmail account will be able to access their summer registration IF they have communicated with their advisors and had their accounts switched on. Be sure to contact advisors asap. For students returning after an absence who do not have active lionmail accounts, a hard-copy enrollment form will be filed.

Talking to your advisor about the classes you want does NOT guarantee that you will have a spot in those classes. You must enroll yourself on a first-come first-served basis.

We will have a computer-based registration for those who are unsure of using the student portal on Saturday, March 28, from 10 am to noon. If you plan to attend, please let your advisor know. The room number is still to be determined.

The Fall Schedule is available on the Lindenwood website but we are not conducting fall registration at this time—only Summer. Make sure that when you enroll for Summer you change the term to Su I 09.

We appreciate your understanding of the changes to the 8-week summer term and we will try to make accommodations when course offerings pose a hardship on you. For example, we will extend the acceptance of on-line education courses through the summer. If you have special concerns about your schedule, please talk to your advisor.

Please take notice of several non-traditional courses offered this summer, especially in Belleville. We are pleased to add a new elective—Art Therapy—to the St. Charles schedule. This class has been taught by Sherry Parashak, an experienced LPC and Art Therapist, in several counseling programs. We are delighted to offer it to our students. It will be conducted M-F during the day from June 15-26. If your schedule allows for it, consider our latest innovation.

All professional internship classes will be meeting one night a week and instructors of these small classes will be available to enrollees by phone, e-mail, or in person, before the term starts, and well after the term ends July 31. It is anticipated that students will get Incompletes and will have until the first of December to complete their 300 hours. With only 8 weeks, it will be critical for students to be prepared to present case presentations with tape transcriptions very early in the term. Be ready to hit the ground running!
