 - Lifestyle and career
- Have you completed at least one of the following courses?
 - Crisis Intervention
 - Hypnotherapy
 - Family Therapy
 - Marital Therapy
- Have one written reference from their counseling theory/lab instructor. [Instructor can email Dr. Munro or Prof. Andreoff]
- Have one written referral from another instructor. [Instructor can email Dr. Munro or Prof. Andreoff]
