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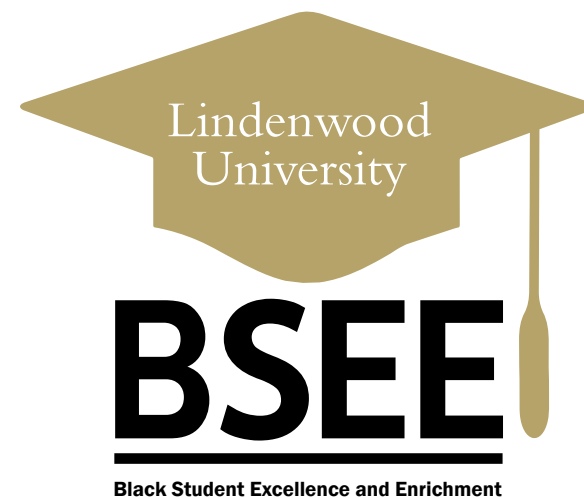

## OBJECTIVES

Black freshmen and sophomore students who attend Lindenwood University.

## PROGRAM

### FALL SEMESTER

*(MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS):*

- Welcome/orientation meeting.
- 1 general meeting/workshop a month.
- 1 midterm academic review meeting.
- Must be an active member of at least one student organization.
- Students whose GPA is below a 2.0 will have mandatory academic review meetings.
- Sophomore students must join the Elevate Leadership Program.

### SPRING SEMESTER

*(MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS):*

- Opening meeting.
- 1 general body meeting/workshop a month.
- Complete at least 5 hours of community service.
- Must be an active member of at least one student organization.
- Students whose GPA is below a 2.0 will have mandatory academic review meetings.
- Sophomore students must join/be actively engaged with the Elevate Leadership Program.
