To complete the <u>Doctorate in Instructional Leadership all students must</u>:

- Have completed an Education Research course as a prerequisite.
- 2. Maintain a GPA of 3.5 or higher within each doctoral course, and a GPA of 3.66 or higher in the first nine hours of courses.
- Complete EDA 75000 with a grade of B or higher. Must be taken within the first year after admission to the program.
- 4. Complete a minimum of 24 hours in residence. Complete a minimum of 48 hours beyond the master's degree.
- 5. Earn no more than two C's during the entire program of study.
- 6. Pass the comprehensive exam.
- 7. Complete the degree requirements within five calendar years of the date of the first day of the first term in which the student begins the graduate program.
- 8. Enroll in EDA 78000 for each semester the dissertation is NOT complete.
- 9. Must submit Degree Application by deadline.
