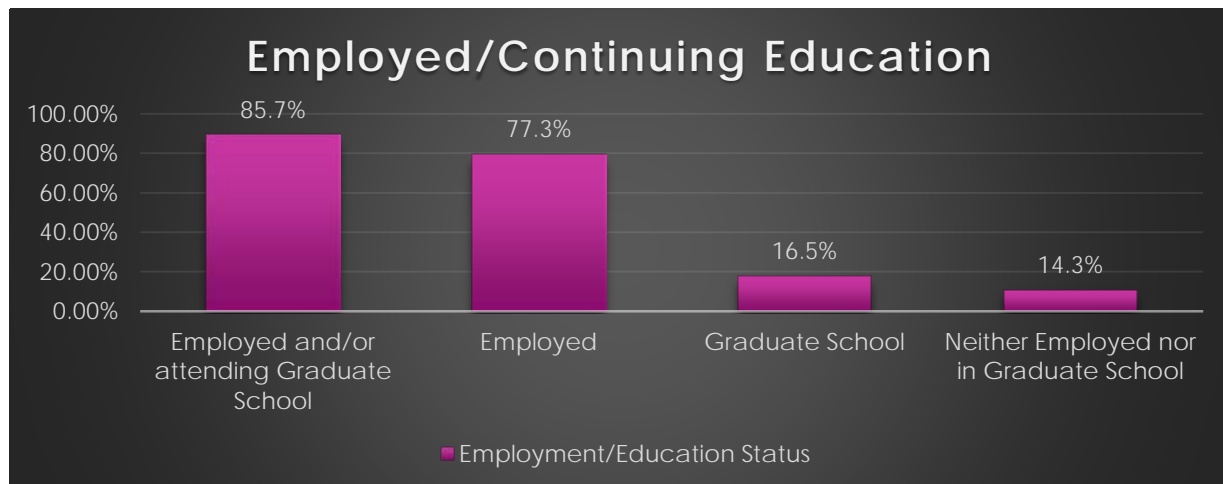

## Executive Summary

The First Destination Survey Report includes both sanitized and aggregated data from surveys administered to 3,192 Lindenwood University alumni earning Bachelor's or Master's degrees during the time period beginning July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2016. Of that total, the Career Development Center was able to verify the status of 1,086 alumni representing a response/knowledge rate of 34%.

Out of the 1,086 responses, 895 alumni indicated that they were either employed and/or attending graduate school, representing a total placement rate of 85.7% for both undergraduate and graduate students. 807 (77.3%) alumni indicated they were employed either full or part-time or serving in the military, 172 (16.5%) alumni indicated they were attending graduate or professional school, and 149 (14.3%) alumni reported that they were not employed nor were they attending graduate school.



The survey was administered at various intervals within six months of graduation. The first round of surveys was made available to graduates in an online format through the student portal, then in a paper format during Graduating Student Day. Career Center staff continued reaching out to alumni via phone, email, and social media to gather information for this report for six months following graduation. In addition, the report also includes information reported to the Career Center by members of the faculty.

Each respondent was able to select one or more of the following options that best described their current employment and education status: Employed full-time, Serving full-time in the military, Attending graduate or professional school, Self-employed, Employed part-time, Not seeking employment or Seeking employment. Because respondents were able to select more than one option, the combined total of "Employed," "Attending Graduate or Professional School," and "Neither Employed nor in Graduate School" do not equal 100%.

## Undergraduate & Graduate Breakdown 2015 – 2016

The tables & figures below provide First Destination information for graduates broken down by undergraduate and graduate. The two tables include both St. Charles and Belleville campus respondents (“Campus: All”) and respondents from all of the academic schools combined.

As indicated in Table 1, there were 663 undergraduate respondents to the survey. Of that total, 505 (80.7%) indicated that they were employed full or part-time or were attending graduate or professional school. 121 (19.3%) of the survey respondents indicated that they were not employed nor were they attending graduate or professional school.

As shown in Table 2, we received information from 541 graduate students for the survey. From that total, 491 (90.8%), specified that they were either employed or attending graduate or professional school. 50 (9.2%) of the graduate respondents reported they were neither employed nor attending graduate/professional school.

## Statistical Summary for St. Charles Campus 2015 – 2016

Tables 3 and 4 provide employment and graduate/professional school outcome information for both undergraduate and graduate students from the St. Charles campus.

Table 3 gives an overview of the data collected from the 601 undergraduate students from the St. Charles campus who responded to the survey. Of that total, 82% reported employment or continuing education; 18% (102) undergraduates reported neither being employed nor attending graduate school.

Table 4 features the data collected from 383 graduate students who responded to the First Destination Survey from the St. Charles campus. Of that total, 93.9% (355) indicated that they were either employed or attending graduate or professional school. Only 6.1% (23) reported neither being employed nor attending graduate school.

## Statistical Summary for Belleville Campus 2015 – 2016

There were 62 undergraduates from the Belleville campus who supplied information for the 2015-2016 First Destination Survey. From that group, 67.8% reported being employed or attending graduate/professional school. As demonstrated on Table 5, 19 respondents (32.2%), indicated that they were neither employed nor were they attending graduate/professional school.

Table 6 provides an overview of the data collected from the 40 graduate students who responded to the survey from the Belleville campus. From that group, 87.5% (35) reported that they were either employed or attending graduate/professional school after graduation. 12.5% (5 respondents) of the graduate student group indicated that they were neither employed nor were they attending graduate/professional school.
