Undergraduate Day Admissions Check List First Time Freshmen



Complete the LU Application

- Fill out a paper application or apply online at <https://applylu.lindenwood.edu/login.asp>.
- The application will be processed once you pay the \$30 application fee.



Send Transcripts

- Admission requirements:
 - A minimum high school cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.5
 - A minimum ACT composite score of 20 or
 - A minimum SAT (reading & Math) score of 1020
- Send current, official high school transcript including registrar signature/stamp. Final high school transcripts must be sent after completion of high school diploma and must include a graduation date and registrar signature/stamp.
- Dual enrollment transcripts need to come from the university giving credit.



Recommended Paperwork

- Personal Resume
 - Include sports/extracurricular activities, clubs, or organizations from high school, offices held, part-time jobs, community service hours, and any organizations outside of high school that you are associated with or have received accolades from.
- Personal Essay (choose 1 topic)
 - Topic: "What are your short and long term goals?"
 - Topic: "How do you plan to be successful here at LU?"
- Letters of recommendation
 - Should come from teachers and/or principal.
 - No more than 3 are necessary.



Apply for financial Aid (LU Code: 002480)

- The net price calculator will use your previous year's taxes to obtain your EFC prior to October 1st. <https://lindenwood.studentaidcalculator.com/survey.aspx>
- The FAFSA is available after October 1st for the subsequent school year and needs to be filed as soon as possible to meet the state aid deadline of December 31st. www.fafsa.ed.gov
