Please be advised that you can now access Lindenwood’s **Assurance Argument** and **Monitoring Report on the Assessment of Student Learning** in Workday. Go to the “Useful Links” Worklet and, once there, find the reports in the “Direct Links” section. Note: you will not be able to access the evidence documents that are linked within the Assurance Argument (those documents are housed within the HLC Assurance System). Many of you have had input into the writing of these two reports and many of you have reviewed earlier drafts of the reports. Now is your chance to read and become familiar with the final versions of what we submitted to HLC on October 9th.
