

HLC Fact of the Week:
“Student Opinion Survey”
(March 24, 2017)

As a part of Lindenwood’s upcoming accreditation evaluation and site visit, HLC (Higher Learning Commission) will be conducting a student opinion survey. The results of the survey are intended to help the visiting team identify possible questions to be used during on-site meetings with faculty, staff, and students. The survey allows for all students to participate in the review and accreditation process by voicing opinions on topics important to them.

Two months prior to the peer review team’s visit, a link to the survey will be shared with Lindenwood students and the survey will remain open for 10 days. One month prior to the visit, HLC will aggregate the data and make the data and all student responses available to the peer review team and the institution.
