Why is accreditation important? Here are a few reasons:

- Assures stakeholders that Lindenwood offers a high quality educational experience (public accountability)
- Affords our institution an opportunity to engage in the soul-searching process of internal evaluation and institutional improvement
- Self-scrutiny is a prudent and healthy practice
- Necessary for federal student financial assistance program
- Necessary to ensure transferability of credits to other institutions
- Accredited degree programs (specialized accreditation) require institutional accreditation
