HLC Fact of the Week: "Third Party Comment on Upcoming HLC Visit"

As part of its <u>Federal Compliance process</u>, HLC requires institutions undergoing a comprehensive evaluation to publish basic information about the visit in appropriate publications and invite the public to provide written comments to HLC. HLC forwards all comments to the institution being reviewed and to the peer review team to include in their review of the institution.
