Building Background:

- Four floors
- Fire extinguisher locations:
 - 0 8, 23, 120, 122, 207, 221, 308, 318
- Fire alarm locations:
 - Second floor: north, south, and center stairwells
 - Third floor: north and south stairwells

Building Evacuation Route:

In the event of a bomb threat or fire in the building, all occupants need to immediately leave the building using the closest exit. Once outside, proceed to the assembly area.

- Rooms 17-25: north basement exit, north staircase fire escape, OR center staircase exit leading to main entrance
- Rooms 101-115: use exit from the east main exit OR south stairwell
- Rooms 114-125: use exit from the north OR east stairwell
- Rooms 202-213: use the center OR south stairs
- Rooms 214-225: use the center OR north stairs
- Rooms 302-313: use the center OR south stairs
- Rooms 314-325: use the center OR north stairs

All occupants, when exiting the building, are required to report to the assembly area for a building evacuation.

Evacuation Assembly Area:

Grassy area behind Niccolls Hall

Bad Weather/Safe Area: In the event of severe weather, all building occupants should seek shelter in the lowest part of the building. If unable to get to the shelter area, seek a windowless room or hallway on the first floor of the building.
