\*Graduation Rate: Measures the progress of students who began their studies as full-time, first-time degree- or certificate seeking students by showing the percentage of these students who complete their degree within a 150% of "normal time" for completing the program.

\*\* This number is expected to change following the 2018-2019 academic year. Currently, there are two students admitted into the program during the 2014-2015 school year expected to graduate in 2018-2019. Upon successful completion of the program, this number is expected to change to 83% (19/23).
