

### Undergraduate Day Admissions Check List Transfer Students

- 
- Complete the LU Application**
    - Fill out a paper application or apply online at <https://applylu.lindenwood.edu/login.asp>.
    - The application will be processed once you pay the \$30 application fee.
  
  - Send Transcripts**
    - Requirements: transfer students must meet the minimum requirement of: 2.0 transfer GPA with 24 transferable credit hours.
    - If less than 2.0 or 24 hours, student must provide official high school transcripts and official ACT or SAT score for further evaluation.
    - All Final transcripts need to be official in a sealed envelope from the institution.
  
  - Recommended Paperwork**
    - Personal Resume
      - Include sports/extracurricular activities, clubs, or organizations from high school, offices held, part-time jobs, community service hours, and any organizations outside of high school that you are associated with or have received accolades from.
    - Personal Essay (choose 1 topic)
      - Topic: "What are your short and long term goals?"
      - Topic: "How do you plan to be successful here at LU?"
    - Letters of recommendation
      - Should come from teachers and/or principal.
      - No more than 3 are necessary.
  
  - Apply for Financial Aid (LU Code: 002480)**
    - The net price calculator will use your previous year's taxes to obtain your EFC prior to October 1<sup>st</sup>. <https://lindenwood.studentaidcalculator.com/survey.aspx>
    - The FAFSA is available after October 1<sup>st</sup> for the subsequent school year and needs to be filed as soon as possible to meet the state aid deadline of December 31<sup>st</sup>. [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)
