This multi-use performing arts facility opened in the fall of 2008, and has been entertaining the St. Louis Metro Area ever since. Some of our most exciting performances have featured Tony Bennett, Jay Leno, Willie Nelson, Amy Grant, Kenny Loggins, Patti LaBelle, Trace Adkins, The Beach Boys, and Penn & Teller, just to name a few. The theater is equally known for its series of national tours including: *CATS*, *Grease*, *Jesus Christ Superstar*, *Legally Blonde*, *Movin' Out*, *Annie*, and much more! With its intimate setting and accessible location, the J. Scheidegger Center for the Arts provides an unparalleled experience in arts and entertainment.

In addition to our annual Touring Series, the facility is also home to Lindenwood University's School of Arts, Media, and Communications which produces regular performances and exhibitions by students in the theatre, dance, art, fashion, technical theatre, and music programs. Venues include the 1,200 seat Lindenwood Theater, the versatile Emerson Black Box Theater, and the Boyle Family Art Gallery.

Patrons who visit the Scheidegger Center are treated to free, adjacent, and lighted parking just minutes from I-70. Other amenities include: Optional valet parking, an onsite box office open year-round from 9 – 5, Monday to Friday, beer and wine available for purchase at Touring Series events, and online ticketing services at LUBoxOffice.com. As we look ahead to the 19-20 season, we are getting back to our roots with a series that offers a wider array of entertainment options. From late-night legend Jay Leno to relative newcomer Jon Dorenbos, from country songstress Martina McBride to the national tour of *Finding Neverland*, there is so much to see, hear, and experience.
