## EARLY REGISTRATION SP I 20 & SP II 20

## MFA students will be able to enroll themselves in classes for both upcoming spring terms beginning TUESDAY, OCTOBER 29.

With our change to 8-week terms comes several new changes for our registration process:

- Registration begins earlier than in the previous quarter system.
- Students are no longer required to post a registration response in Canvas. Portals will be enabled for self-enrollment on the registration start date at 7am Central Time.
- Students are highly encouraged to enroll themselves in classes through the Student Portal to ensure the best chance for enrollment in preferred classes. (Advisors can enroll students if there is an emergency situation.)
- Students may enroll themselves in multiple terms.
  - SP I 20 (1/13-3/6) & SP II 20 (3/16-5/9) registration opens 10/29/19
  - SU 20 (5/18-7/12) & FA I 20 (late August to mid-October) & FA II 20 (mid-October to mid-December—no break between the end of FA I and the beginning of FA II) registration start date will be posted on the <u>Important Dates</u> page when available
- Students will choose new terms in the Student Portal. To change the term in the portal, click change at the top left by your name, then choose the correct term from the drop-down list. When registering for SP I term beginning January 13, students will choose the term called SP I MBA 20 (even though it says MBA, it is the correct 8-week term for our MFA program). For SP II term beginning March 16, students will choose term SP II MBA 20. See all registration instructions linked below.
