General On-Campus Housing Guidelines:

The following is a summary of University housing guidelines. For additional information, refer to the Student Handbook or contact the Residential Life Office at (636) 949-4848 or ResLife@lindenwood.edu.

- Each resident is expected to complete the check-in process at the beginning of each academic term and the checkout process at the end of each academic term.
- In order for a room assignment to be processed, a student must sign his/her Enrollment Financial Aid agreement/award, pay the \$200 housing deposit, and submit the Residential Life Student Occupancy Contract.
- No room change may be made without the approval of the Residential Life Office. Any unauthorized change will result in a fine and potential further discipline.
- If a student is planning to be absent from housing for more than a day, they should notify the Area Coordinator.
- Campus housing will be closed during University breaks, and requests to remain in campus housing during breaks must be submitted in writing to the Residential Life Office. University will accommodate such requests in its sole discretion.
- Any lost or duplicated keys (including keys not returned to University at the end of the academic term) will result in charges to the student.
- For any maintenance requests, the student should contact the Area Coordinator.
- Students must observe quiet hours for campus housing and keep noise to a minimum.
- Students are permitted to have visitors in accordance with the residential visitation policy in the Student Handbook and failure to follow the guidelines will result in disciplinary action.
- All University residence furniture must remain in the residence at all times. Any additional furniture brought in to residence halls must be approved in advance by the Area Coordinator of the hall, and MUST be removed at the end of the academic term.
- Emotional Support Animal applications must be received by the Student Support and Accessibility Manager by November 1 for the spring semester and June 1 for the fall semester. Applications will not be accepted past these dates.
- The residence may not be altered in any way (painting, wallpaper, carpet addition or removal, etc.) without the permission of the Director of Campus Facilities.
- Students will be notified each semester of the dates they are eligible to request continuing on-campus housing using the StarRez portal.
