Lindenwood University returned the certification for receipt of these funds from the US Department of Education under the CARES Act on April 11, 2020. Lindenwood was approved and has made these funds available for emergency student relief, and will continue to update information about eligibility and remaining funds as directed by the Department of Education.

Eligibility Criteria	<p><i><u>Be enrolled in a term that was effected by a COVID disruption:</u></i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Spring 2020 or Summer 2020 - Students enrolled for Spring 2020 and/or Summer 2020, and receiving a Pell Grant will automatically be awarded \$2,000 - All other students can appeal for assistance, and will be funded on a first applied, first awarded basis up to \$2,000 for qualified needs/costs <p><i><u>In addition students must:</u></i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Have a FAFSA on file with Lindenwood University - Making satisfactory academic progress (SAP) - Be Verification Complete - Enrolled in an on-ground modality - Be a degree-seeking student
