- Tell me about yourself.
- Why do you want to work for this company?
- Why do you want this position?

- Of all the jobs you have held, which is the one you like the most? Why?
- What motivates you?
- How do you motivate others?
- What do you think about your current or most recent boss?
- Do you have any questions for us?

Behavioral Interview Questions

- Describe a time you successfully used persuasion to get someone to see things your way.
- Give an example of a time that you had to conform to a policy you did not agree with
- Tell me about a time you were able to successfully collaborate with a person even when that person did not personally like you or you did not like that person.
- What is your typical response to dealing with conflict? Give an example.
- Tell me about a difficult decision you've made in the last year.
- Describe a time when you successfully lead a group project.
- Describe a time when you anticipated potential problems and developed preventative measures.
- Tell me about a time when you missed an obvious solution to a problem.
- Describe a time when you set your sights too high or too low.
- Tell me about a time you were forced to make an unpopular decision.
