Building Background

- One floor
- Fire Extinguishers located, 28, 24, 22 and lobby
- Fire Alarms-West main door, north emergency door

Building Evacuation Route

In the event of a bomb threat or fire in the building, all occupants need to immediately leave the building using the closest exit. Once outside, proceed to the assembly area

• Rooms 14-28 West main entrance or North emergency exit door

All students, when exiting the building, are required to report to the assembly area for a building evacuation.

Evacuation Assembly Area: Area between Butler and New Ayres

Weather

In the event of severe weather, all building occupants should seek shelter in the lowest part of the building. If unable to get to the shelter area, seek a windowless room or hallway on the first floor of the building.

Bad Weather Safe Area: Along the North Emergency Exit Hallway
