Building Background:

- Four floors
- Fire extinguisher locations:
 - \circ First floor boiler room
 - o 103, 112, 203, 212, 229, 303, 316, 327, 403, 412, 427
- Fire alarm locations:
 - Center, north, south, east and west stairwells/exits

Building Evacuation Route:

In the event of a bomb threat or fire in the building, all occupants need to immediately leave the building using the closest exit. Once outside, proceed to the assembly area.

- Rooms 101-115: use the south exit at the end of the hall, front OR rear door in center of building
- Rooms 116-127: use the north exit at the end of the hall, front OR rear door in center of building
- Rooms 201-215: use the south exit at the end of the hall OR use center stairs
- Rooms 216-229: use the north exit at the end of the hall OR use center stairs
- Rooms 301-315: use the south exit at the end of the hall OR use center stairs
- Rooms 316-329: use the north exit at the end of the hall OR use center stairs
- Rooms 401-415: use the south exit at the end of the hall OR use center stairs
- Rooms 416-429: use the north exit at the end of the hall OR use center stairs

All occupants, when exiting the building, are required to report to the assembly area for a building evacuation.

Evacuation Assembly Area:

Rear of building on the grassy area next to Pfremmer pond

Bad Weather/Safe Area: In the event of severe weather, all building occupants should seek shelter in the lowest part of the building. If unable to get to the shelter area, seek a windowless room or hallway on the first floor of the building.
