Student Teacher Mandatory Meeting and Weekly Seminars

There will be a **Mandatory Student Teaching Informational Meeting** during the semester applications are submitted. **ALL STUDENT TEACHERS MUST ATTEND THIS MEETING PRIOR TO THE SEMESTER STUDENT TEACHING BEGINS.**

Student teachers must attend all weekly <u>Student Teaching Seminar</u> classes. Seminars typically begin the third week of August for Fall student teaching and the second week of January for Spring student teaching.
