
EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURES: STUMBERG HALL

Building Emergency Coordinator (BEC): Dr. Deb Ayres (636) 949-4405

Building background:

- Three floors
- Fire Extinguishers located by main entrance door and 2nd floor main hallway
- Fire Alarms located at west exit, main south entrance

Building Evacuation Route

In the event of a bomb threat or fire in the building, all occupants need to immediately leave the building using the closest exit. Once outside, proceed to the assembly area

- Third floor: exit down the back stairwell
- Second floor: use front or rear stairwell
- First floor: use front or rear entry doors

All occupants, when exiting the building, are required to report to the assembly area for a building evacuation.

Evacuation Assembly Area: Grass Area Facing Young Hall

Weather

In the event of severe weather, all building occupants should seek shelter in the lowest part of the building. If unable to get to the shelter area, seek a windowless room or hallway on the first floor of the building.

Bad Weather Safe Area: Basement
