# Warner Hall

### Building Background

- Three Floors
- Fire Extinguisher locations: Kitchen, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor south west stairwell, basement
- Fire alarm locations, none

### Building Evacuation Route

In the event of a bomb threat or fire in the building, all occupants need to immediately leave the building using the closest exit. Once outside, proceed to the assembly area

- 1<sup>st</sup> floor: exit northeast exit
- Sunroom: north side exit/ south exit
- 2<sup>nd</sup> floor living room: 2 center stairs exit lead to main floor exits
- Annex: north side of building
- Basement: north exit or stairs to 1<sup>st</sup> floor

All students, when exiting the building, are required to report to the assembly area for a building evacuation. The location will be across the street at McCluer Hall.

**Evacuation Assembly Area:** Across the Street at McCluer Hall

### Weather

In the event of severe weather, all building occupants should seek shelter in the lowest part of the building. If unable to get to the shelter area, seek a windowless room or hallway on the first floor of the building.

**Bad Weather Safe Area:** Lower Level Basement
